Task Description		Family Member Responsible	
Disaster Kit*	Stock the disaster kit and take it if evacuation is necessary. Include items you might want to take to an evacuation shelter. Remember to include medications and eye glasses.		
Be informed	Maintain access to NOAA or local radio, TV, email or text alerts for important and current information about disasters.		
Family Medical Information	Make sure the household medical information is taken with us if evacuation is necessary.		
Financial Information	Obtain copies of bank statements and cash in the event ATMs and credit cards do not work due to power outages. Bring copies of utility bills as proof of residence in applying for assistance.		
Pet Information	Evacuate our pet(s), keep a phone list of pet-friendly motels and animal shelters, and assemble and take the pet disaster kit.	/	
Sharing and Maintaining the Plan	Share the completed plan with those who need to know. Meet with household members every 6 months or as needs change to update household plan.

Our Emergency Supplies Kit

As you've learned, in some emergencies you may have to leave your home for a safer place. To be prepared, put together an emergency supplies kit. That way you'll have everything you need to stay safe and comfortable while you're away from home.

This checklist shows items that belong in an emergency supplies kit. Ask your family to go on a scavenger hunt with you to find some items you may already have at home. Check off each item that you find. Work together to pack up an emergency supplies kit for your home.

Three-day supply of water (one gallon of water per person, per day)
Three-day supply of canned and dried food, and a can opener
Portable radio and extra batteries
Flashlight and extra batteries
Cell phone and charger
First aid kit
Hygiene items (soap, hand sanitizer, moist towelettes, toilet paper, etc.)
Matches in a waterproof container
Whistle (to signal for help)
Extra clothing and blankets
Cooking and eating utensils
Cash and coins (in case credit card readers and ATMs aren't working)
Personal needs items such as prescription medications, eye glasses, contact lens solution, and hearing aid batteries
Items for infants, such as formula, diapers, bottles, and pacifiers, if needed
Tools, pet supplies, a map of the local area, and other items to meet your unique needs

You should also keep an emergency supplies kit in your car. You'll need:

Flashlight, extra batteries, and maps

Cell phone car charger

First aid kit

White distress flag

Tire repair kit, pump, booster/jumper cables, and flares

 Bottled water and non-perishable foods such as granola bars

Seasonal supplies: Winter – blanket, hat, mittens, shovel, sand, tire chains, windshield scraper, glow-in-the-dark distress flag; Summer – sunscreen lotion (SPF 15 or greater), shade item (umbrella, wide brimmed hat, etc.)

Suggestion! Store your kit in a convenient place known to everyone in your home. Keep items in air-tight plastic bags. Refill your kit with fresh water, fresh batteries, right-size clothes, etc. at least every six months.
